

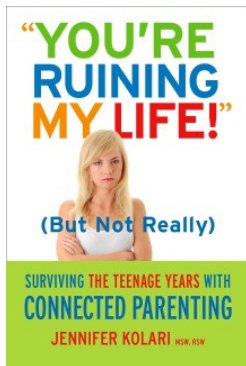
Parent Information Session:

Tackling Bullying and Other Obstacles to Kids' Learning & Well-being

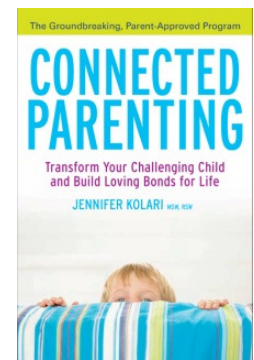
